	ACTIVITY GUIDELINES
	The candidate must :-
Test sequence	<ul> <li>Complete all pre-start and running checks before any activity takes place</li> <li>Only complete the shutdown procedures at the end of the test</li> <li>All additional test requirements can be completed in any order</li> </ul>
Operator safety & observations	<ul> <li>Seat belt must be worn unless stated in the employer's risk assessment / method statement</li> <li>The vehicle must be serviceable and meet the current legislation</li> <li>Must check terrain prior to traversing the area</li> <li>Must look in the direction of travel</li> </ul>
Travelling to work area	<ul> <li>The candidate must:-</li> <li>Travel up and down a gradient, conduct a failed climb recovery</li> <li>Travel through a restriction in a forward and reverse direction</li> <li>Travel over varying terrain</li> <li>Use 4 wheel drive and diff lock at appropriate times</li> </ul>
Water crossing	<ul> <li>Candid must check vehicle is suitable</li> <li>Candidate must check water is safe to cross</li> <li>Candidate should drive through water</li> <li>(If water is not available or safe this may be covered verbally)</li> </ul>
Towing	<ul> <li>Vehicle should tow a suitable implement if the vehicle is equipped to do so</li> <li>Implement should be coupled correctly and safely</li> <li>Implement should be towed forward around a suitable course to test drivers understanding</li> <li>Implement should be reversed into an area from both near and offsides</li> </ul>
End of shift checks	<ul> <li>Vehicle should be parked as instructed by examiner</li> <li>Engine should be allowed to tick over to protect turbo bearings</li> <li>The hand brake must be applied</li> <li>The key must be removed and vehicle isolated and secured</li> <li>The driver must carry a post use check for damage and faults and report anything found</li> </ul>
Additional notes	<ul> <li>A verbal description to the instructor of the pre-start checks would be acceptable if the machine is hot</li> <li>The operator's manual must be accessible</li> <li>The slope must be of sufficient incline to enable the candidate to demonstrate the correct procedures for traveling up and down a gradient as per manufacturers recommendations</li> <li>If water is not available or is unsafe a verbal description of the pre-checks and crossing procedures is acceptable</li> <li>If the vehicle is to be used with a towed implement then the towing part of the test must be undertaken if it is not the card must be restricted to not for towing off road</li> </ul>

Specifications	<ul> <li>The vehicle must be fitted with working 4-wheel drive and diff locks manual or automatic and in good condition</li> <li>Test route should be sufficient to enable the instructor to see each element of the test on a minimum of two occasions</li> <li>Towed implement can be of any type as long as it is suitable for the towing vehicle and is in good condition</li> </ul>
Test timings	The full test must be completed within 1hr 15min
Note	It is recommended that all learners completing basic training receive a minimum 7hr Health, Safety and Environment and Induction Training
