

Practical Test for N722 Material Re-Handler

	ACTIVITY GUIDELINES
	The learner must:
Test sequence	 Complete all pre-start and running checks before any activity takes place Only complete the shutdown procedures at the end of the test All additional test requirements can be completed in any order
Operator safety & observations	 Seat belt must be worn if stated in the employers risk assessment / method statement The machine must be serviceable, meets the current legislation and fitted with correct attachments only
Travelling to work	The candidate must:
area	 Travel through a restriction left and right in a forward and reverse direction Travel through an area of restricted head room
Setting up to	Prepare and set up the machine for sorting duties
operate	Prepare and set up the machine for loading duties
Load vehicle or hopper	Load material on to a vehicle or hopper
Sort materials	Operator will pick out materials as identified by the examiner and move to new position
Maintain a clean working area	The operator must after loading or sorting maintain as far as possible maintain a clear floor area
Change attachment	Remove and attach grab / attachment correctly and safely
Shutdown procedures	Machine parked in a safe position with the engine and isolator key removed and handed to the instructor
Additional notes	 A verbal description to the instructor of the pre-start checks would be acceptable if the machine is hot The operator's manual must be accessible
	When the attachment is released from machine the boom must be raised and slewed away from the released attachment. The machine must be moved and reposition before re-attaching
Specifications	 The loading vehicle / hopper must be filled to the capacity (minimum 2 loads) The examiner should see the candidate sort a minimum of 6 objects
Test timings	The full test must be completed within 1hrs 30min
Note	It is recommended that all learners completing basic training receive a minimum 7hr Health, Safety, Environment and Induction Training
